PRIVACY NOTICE
**on the processing of personal data of applicants and participants of the 3rd
International Congress of HADO**

Budapest, 31 May 2026

The **Hungarian Association for Dentofacial Orthopedics and Orthodontics** (hereinafter referred to as the “**Data Controller**”) processes the personal data of individuals registering for and participating in its **3rd International Congress** (hereinafter referred to as the “**Event**”) in accordance with applicable legal regulations, in particular:

- **Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council** of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (**General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR**), and
- **Act CXII of 2011 of Hungary** on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information.

In accordance with the provisions of the GDPR, the Data Controller hereby provides the following information regarding the processing of personal data of applicants and participants of the Event (hereinafter referred to as the “**Data Subjects**”).

2. Legal Basis for Data Processing

Registration for and participation in the Event are voluntary. By registering for and attending the Event, Data Subjects provide their consent to the processing of their personal data as described in this Privacy Notice.

3. Source of Personal Data

Personal data are collected directly from the Data Subjects through the registration process and through voluntary disclosure during participation in the Event.

4. Categories of Personal Data Processed

The Data Controller processes and stores all personal data provided by Data Subjects confidentially.

The categories of personal data processed may include:

- full name,
 - professional qualification,
 - professional registration/license number,
 - billing name/company name,
 - billing address,
 - tax identification number,
 - telephone number,
 - e-mail address,
 - HADO membership status (including start date),
 - photographs, image and audio recordings,
 - and any other personal data voluntarily provided by the Data Subject during registration or participation in the Event.

5. Purpose of Data Processing

The purposes of processing personal data are:

- identification of participants where necessary;
 - administration of registration and participation;
 - communication related to the Event;
 - preparation and publication of photographs, audio recordings, and video recordings taken during the Event.

6. Data Retention Period

Personal data will be stored until the Data Subject explicitly withdraws consent, but no later than **12 months after the conclusion of the Event**.

Upon receipt of a withdrawal request, personal data will be deleted without undue delay and no later than within **24 hours**, unless retention is required by law.

Exceptions apply to data required for **tax and accounting purposes**, which shall be retained in accordance with Hungarian law:

- tax-related data: **5 years** following the relevant tax year;
- accounting records: **8 years**.

After expiration of the applicable retention period, paper-based records will be destroyed and electronically stored data will be permanently deleted.

7. Recipients and Categories of Recipients

Personal data may be transferred to contracted **data processors** engaged by the Data Controller for the purpose of providing services related to the Event, including:

- **ZandE Accounting and Tax Advisory Ltd.** (Tax No.: 12040814-2-42)

Personal data may also be disclosed to competent public authorities where required by applicable law.

8. Access to Personal Data and Data Security Measures

Access to personal data is limited exclusively to individuals involved in the organisation, administration, and financial management of the Event, strictly on a need-to-know basis.

Paper-based documents containing personal data are stored securely at the registered office of the Data Controller.

Printed documents are destroyed using secure shredding procedures, while electronic data are protected by appropriate technical and organisational security measures.

9. Rights of Data Subjects

Data Subjects have the right to:

- request information regarding the processing of their personal data;
- access their personal data;
- request correction of inaccurate personal data;
- request restriction of processing;
- withdraw consent at any time;
- request deletion or blocking of personal data where applicable;
- lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- seek legal remedy before the competent authority or court.
